




What is a greeting card?






Let's design and make a card!



1. Choose a recipient – who are you going to send a card to?
2. Share a message – what do you want to say? How do you want to make them feel?
3. Design or choose images – what pictures could convey your message? Could you add stickers and colours?




How to make your card:

1. Cut out your template.
2. Create your main front design on this part.
You can use words, pictures, colours and stickers.
3. Fold your card in half.
4. On the inside, write your recipient's name, your message and your name.
5. Cut out, fold and stick your envelope (next slide shows you how to do it!)
6. Write your recipient's name (and address if you are posting it) on the envelope.
